Bob, Angie, Bridget and Jacqui met to discuss what each role Angie, Bridget, and Jacqui play. Wanted to learn boundaries, players behind the scene, funding, and other dynamics to help us understand what we can do.

Jacqui (Substance Misuse Prevention Coordinator- SMP):

- ✓ Funded through Bureau of Drug and Alcohol (State of NH).
- ✓ Focused role is 18-25 population.
- ✓ Has to report on prescription drugs, alcohol, marijuana, opioids, tobacco, and suicide. Help the community with substance misuse prevention.
- ✓ Supports Mascoma coalition
- ✓ Dartmouth-Hitchcock is the fiscal agent to Sullivan County so Jacqui may support Sullivan County SMP
- ✓ Your Turn project. Program supports 18-25 year olds.
- ✓ Connect Suicide Trainings
- ✓ Coordinate pre-and post-vention trainings

Bridget (Continuum of Care Facilitator - CoC):

- ✓ Funded through Bureau of Drug and Alcohol (State of NH).
- ✓ Trying to navigate what is working best, so lots of flexibility
- ✓ Builds capacity for substance misuse through support of programs that are already in existence or developing new programs.
- ✓ Identify community needs, develop ways to address the needs, create sustainable solutions
- ✓ Projects: recovery coach in ED, treatment guides, Mothers in Recovery
- ✓ Prevention, Intervention, Recovery- not focused on one drug or age group
- ✓ Increase access and awareness to services, increase collaboration, expand services

Angie (Drug Free Communities Coordinator - DFC):

- ✓ Funded through drug free communities grant- federal- not filtered through state. DHMC is fiscal agent
- ✓ Focused role is youth
- ✓ Focus: alcohol, marijuana, opioids, tobacco, and suicide.
- ✓ Past 30 day use, perception of risk, parent approval, peer approval
- ✓ Supports Lebanon PUSH, Circle Up!, Hartford Community Coalition
- ✓ Work has to be through evidence based practice and process. Mostly done through coalitions.
- ✓ Assessment of community (UV community survey, YRBS, Coalition Member Survey)
- ✓ Initiate, support, build and maintain sustainable coalitions
- ✓ Create logic models, 7 strategies, campaigns, lock boxes
- ✓ Coalition Training



Shared Responsibilities:

- ✓ Support local coalitions.
- ✓ Guiding Principles: Engage diverse stakeholders, Cultural competence, Sustainability
- ✓ Grants- bring resources into the region
- ✓ Educate - table at community events, presentations, etc.
- ✓ Report/share data
- ✓ Twin State Safe Meds campaign
- ✓ Coordinate community events and forums
