Getting Started

This guide will help you find treatment services for people whose alcohol and other drug use is negatively affecting their lives.

The good news is that recovery from alcohol and drug problems is possible. It's never too late to seek help! Any first step is a good step and this booklet can help you find the right place to start your search. This booklet is not meant to substitute professional consultation, evaluation, and treatment, rather it is designed to streamline your search for support and get you connected as quickly as possible. The providers in this guide will work with you to decide on the best course of treatment. If you are already engaged in treatment but are interested in exploring other services then start a conversation with your current provider as they may be able to assist you.

Choosing a Treatment Provider

Private providers

are marked with a green dot. Private providers are people who provide specific service(s) and are not part of an agency (e.g. a private counselor).

Providers who offer opioid treatment

are marked with a blue dot. These providers offer medication-assisted treatment (MAT) using a combination of medication and counseling to help people move through withdrawal symptoms and manage cravings following opioid use.

Providers who offer support for family and friends

are marked with a pink dot. These services specialize in providing resources for families and friends of a person with addiction.

Intensive Outpatient Programs,

often called IOPs, are marked with a black dot. IOPs are a treatment program sometimes recommended following clinical assessment for people who may require increased counseling support but who may not be appropriate for residential/inpatient treatment.

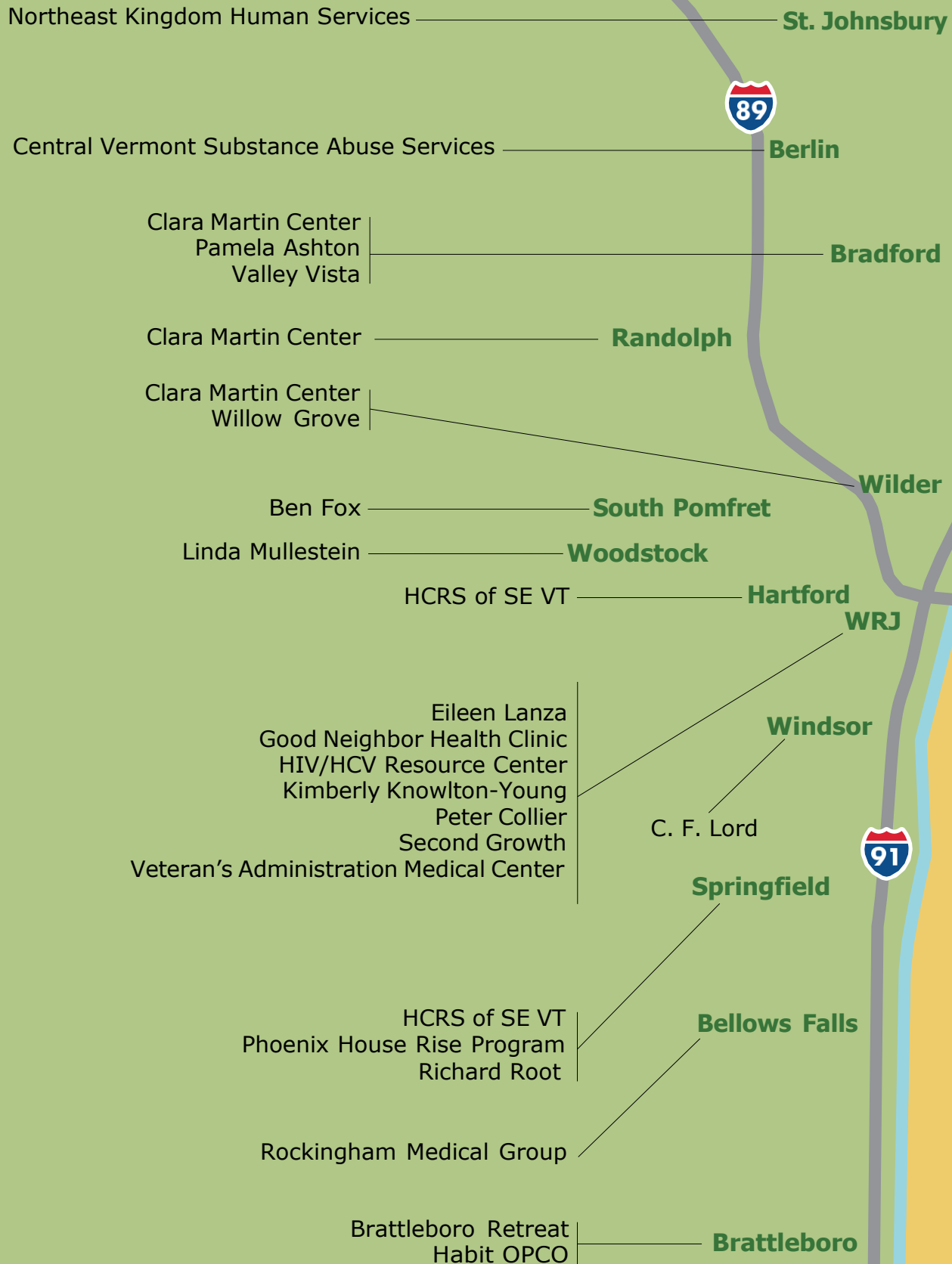

Treatment of Heroin, Opioids, and Prescription Pain Medication Use

If you use opioids such as heroin, or prescription pain killers like hydrocodone or oxycodone, you may need treatment services that include medications such as methadone, buprenorphine, or naltrexone to help you avoid withdrawal symptoms and cravings. Your doctor or substance use treatment provider can help you understand if medication-assisted treatment may be best for your needs, and help you find a local treatment provider.

If you are pregnant and are using heroin, other opioids, prescription pain medications, alcohol, or other substances, contact your OB/Gyn, substance use treatment, and/or primary care provider as soon as possible to identify the best type of care for both you and your developing fetus.

Safe Use, Safe Storage and Safe Disposal of Medications

School-Based Alcohol and Drug Services

Students at most high schools and middle schools can get free and confidential alcohol, drug, and mental health services at their school. Common services include education; problem solving; alcohol, drug, and mental health screening; brief counseling; referral to treatment services; and recovery support. Ask your school if they have a Student Assistance Program or Behavioral Health Provider.

Case Management Services

Care coordination and case management—many people struggling with substance misuse also face tremendous pressures from debt, housing instability, medical, dental and emotional neglect. Nurses, counselors, case managers and practices are ready to help them address and resolve these issues.

As you contact treatment providers ask if there is a case manager staff that works with the practice. They can make a tremendous difference. They want to help you!

What If I Can't Afford Treatment?
