

## **Where can I get more Naloxone (Narcan)?**

1. **The NH Doorway** program makes Naloxone available to individuals who are at risk for overdose for little to no cost. These kits are available at your local Hub – There are 9 Hubs across the state. Check which Hub is within your service area:

  - Doorway at DHMC: 85 Mechanic St (DHMC Addiction Treatment program at the Rivermill Complex), Lebanon, NH 03766-1537
  - Doorway at Cheshire Medical Center: 640 Marlboro St, Keene, NH 03431-4049
2. Your primary care physician can write **a prescription for naloxone** that you must purchase at a pharmacy.
3. You can purchase naloxone at a **NH pharmacy with standing orders**, which sells the medication **without a prescription**. Check with your local pharmacy.  
*Note: D-H Pharmacy has a standing order.*
4. You may be able to receive free kits through your provider at your **health center, treatment provider, or local recovery center**. Contact them directly.
5. You may attend a **training held by your NH Regional Public Health Network**, where free kits may be available. The Upper Valley & Greater Sullivan County PHNs host training events when requested. Contact [GSCPHN@hitchcock.org](mailto:GSCPHN@hitchcock.org) for training.
